Minutes of IQAC Meeting held on 21 April 2022 at Board Room

The Chairperson of IQAC, Dr. K. Nirmala welcomed all members. The meeting started with discussion on minutes of the previous meeting and approval of agenda for the current meeting. The following points were discussed in the meeting.

1. Introduction of Remedial Sessions

Online teaching and learning comes with its own merits and demerits. Certain concepts which can be understood easily through face to face interaction can become challenging in an online class. In order to resolve all such issues regarding online teaching-learning, it was proposed that remedial classes in all subjects be organized to benefit all the students. Framework for the same was discussed in the meeting.

2. Conduction of Mock Offline Exams

Regular practice of writing helps students to express themselves better during exams. Unfortunately, due to a long lockdown and online mode of education, the mandatory written work took a backseat. And students lost touch with writing.

To address this issue, Dr. Kavita Suyawanshi, HOD, MCA suggested that mock offline exams should be conducted for both MBA and MCA. This additional writing practice will give students the required confidence before they take up their exams.

3. Introduction of Add on Certificate Courses

Dr. Shalaka Parker, Dean MBA, came up with the suggestion that **Add on Certificate Courses** should be introduced for MBA and MCA students. This will give them knowledge beyond the curriculum and help them to enhance their credit scores. Further, these certificates will improve their chances of selection during the campus recruitment process.
