Minutes of IQAC Meeting held on 27th October 2023 at Board Room

Dr. K. Nirmala, Chairman of IQAC, welcomed all members. She read the Minutes of the previous meeting which was held on **28th July 2023**. The MOM were confirmed by all the present members. Thereafter, she initiated the discussion on the following Agenda Points.

1. National Conference- February 2024

Dr. K. Nirmala, Chairman of IQAC proposed to conduct “**National Conference on SDG**” in the month of February 2024. She suggested that various Industry Experts from various fields will be part of this Conference. Academia will be also be part of the Conference where they can present and publish their research papers. Preparations regarding the same will be initiated soon. Concerned Faculty members from both the programmes will be given various tasks regarding the conference.

2. Examination Module Implementation on Coll Poll ERP.

Dr. K. Nirmala, shared that the Examination module in Coll Poll is further enhanced with regards to its usage by adding subject wise schema for Unit Term Exam, Mid Term and End Term Examination for MCA and MBA. Dr Kavita Suryawanshi further endorsed it.

3. Start of Innovation Cell

Dr. Shalaka Parker, Dean MBA suggested that The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India has established ‘MHRD’s Innovation Cell (MIC)’ to systematically foster the culture of Innovation amongst all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). The objectives of this initiative are to create a vibrant local innovation ecosystem, Start-up supporting Mechanism in HEIs, Establish Function Ecosystem for Scouting Ideas and Pre-incubation of Ideas, Develop

better Cognitive Ability for Technology Students, etc. It is discussed to establish “Institution’s Incubation” Cell in the institute. The suggestion was appreciated by all other members of the meeting.

4. Placed Students in Worldline

Dr. K Nirmala shared that the Institute has been actively participating in the Campus Level Incubation center jointly set up by Akurdi Campus and WorldLine Global Service Hub. As a result, for students of MCA have been placed in Worldline.

5. Webinar on Intellectual Property Rights(IPR) for Faculty Members
